Public Prayers For the Faithful Departed (Traditionally called Cemetery Sunday)



Sacred Heart Novena 3 – 11 June 2021

How to Pray This Novena

Set aside about ten minutes each day. Take your time over the words you read. Linger over a word or a phrase. Repeat it aloud or in silence. Let it rest in your mind and heart. Think about its meaning.



Novena Prayer

Lord Jesus, you have said, 'Ask and you shall receive, seek and you will find, knock and it shall be opened unto you'. I come to you in faith and trust, in love and hope. Let me know your closeness to me and your care for me and for all who are dear to me.

My intention for this Novena is dear to me and I know that what is important to me is important to you. Hear my prayer (mention your intention); grant what I ask, and may I always trust in all that happens in life, you will be close to me as my friend, guide and saviour. And so, most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.

Sunday 6th June Theme: Forgiveness

Prayer: Lord, have mercy on me, forgive me my sins and give me always the joy of your help.

Monday 7th June Theme: Hope

Prayer: May my hope in your love and eternity never fade, O Lord

Tuesday 8th June Theme: Thanks

Prayer: May every prayer I make, O Lord, begin with my thanks to you for your love for me (intercession).

Wednesday 9th June Theme: For Others

Prayer: Be close, O Lord, to all I pray for today, especially Give him/her the blessing of your joy and peace.

Thursday 10th June Theme: For the World

Prayer: Lord, in all I do and say, in my hopes and dreams, may your kingdom come.

Friday 11th June Theme: For Self
