Garden of Remembrance

Bishop McKeown led a Stations of the Cross Remembrance Vigil in St Eugene's Cathedral, Derry on 26/27 March 2021. This Vigil was intended to remember in prayer all those who had died in our diocese since the start of the pandemic.

As the names were read out, a rose plant was brought forward to the sanctuary in the name of each parish. The Garden of Remembrance has now been constructed in the Cathedral grounds, behind the Lourdes Grotto. It names all the parishes of the diocese and includes prayers for the deceased. The rose plants that were brought forward to the sanctuary on the Night of March 26th/27th have been planted there.

The Garden will not be officially dedicated until later. However, parishioners from Drumragh and all parishes in the diocese are welcome to come and pray or reflect at any time but especially during November - this Month of the Holy Souls.
