Re: Church law:

1. **Book your wedding preparation course at least 1yr before hand** with ACCORD: 0288224 2439 or book online [www. Accord.ie](http://www.Accord.ie) or email derry@accordni.com (they only run once a month in Omagh & book up very quickly). Try and have your course completed around 8/9 months prior to wedding date.

2. **4 months prior to wedding date: meet the priest of the parish you live in** to fill out your Church paper work (**Pre Nuptial forms**) and Obtain the **Marriage Notice Application Form** from Fermanagh & Omagh District Council Office or download it online at <https://www.fermanaghomagh.com/app/uploads/2020/01/Marriage-Notice-Form-2020.pdf>

The priest who is celebrating the Marriage Ceremony must sign your form from the Council. For more detailed information on preparing for your wedding check www.drumraghparish.com
