As you may be aware, Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day are fully booked, and for the safety of everyone, we cannot admit anyone who has not booked. The following are the arrangements for those of you who are attending Mass over the Christmas period:

At each Mass, you are asked to:

- Arrive 30 minutes early so that the church can be filled in an orderly way;
- Follow the instructions of the ushers who will show you to a seat.
- Wear a face covering on entry and exit to the church and throughout the Mass;
- Sanitise your hands on entry to and exit from the church;
- Observe social distancing at all times.
- Please try to avoid queues forming at the doors of the church either before or after Mass.
- Your booking will be held until 5 minutes before the start of Mass. After that, your seat cannot be guaranteed.
