



Return to Public Worship in Drumragh

The northern Bishops have announced that public worship may resume in Northern Ireland – however they emphasise the need for caution and the application of all continued health safeguards and that the decision when to resume is the responsibility of each parish. They are encouraging families to stay at home and participate in the Holy Week Ceremonies via live-streaming.

After consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council and the Covid19 Support team the decision has been made to resume public worship in Sacred Heart Church from Wednesday 7th April.

The Parish of Cappagh have decided to go ahead with opening in 2 churches – St Mary's and Christ the King for Sundays and Easter ceremonies. They have asked that attendance would be restricted to parishioners of Cappagh only.
