Unfortunately, as for last year, we expect that social distancing will impact on the number we can accommodate safely in the Church during these Masses. We have started to plan what we can do to ensure the safety of those who attend. For those who feel that it is safe to come to Mass, we will have a booking system to manage the numbers at each Mass. Under the present restrictions, it is estimated that our church can safely accommodate 200-230 people. Full details of the booking process will be given in next week's bulletin.

More help needed – Ensuring the safety of everyone requires the involvement of a large number of volunteers and we are grateful to all those who have assisted in any way, especially with ushering and cleaning. However, we will need a few extra hands for the Christmas Masses. Ideally, we would like a team of 7 ushers and 8 cleaners at each Mass.
