Key Highlights

 The Annual Financial Returns (Year Ended Dec 2022) have been completed and forwarded to the Diocesan Office. This the first complete financial year free of Covid 19 Pandemic restrictions.

While the weekly collections have not recovered to pre-pandemic levels, they are still a reflection of the wonderful generosity of the people of this parish despite the tough economic climate that we are all experiencing.

Currently, **over 50%** of our weekly income comes through **standing order mandates**. Mandates and Gift Aid Form (if you are a tax payer) are available on-line or from the parish office.

• With the support of the Parish Finance Council, the Parish has been prudent in managing its finances. Our aging, listed buildings require continual maintenance and during the financial year 2022 the costs of maintaining and improving parochial property included the following:

New Boiler Sacred Heart Church - £16,199





New Lighting Sacred Heart Church - £24,792

Property costs include a 42% increase in heating and electricity.
